- Conducted groundbreaking research showing a direct link between criminal gangs in rural communities and the international drugs trade.
- Campaigned successfully for the creation of a National Rural Crime Unit within the Police. Campaigned successfully for tougher penalties for those convicted of fly-tipping and DEFRA funding for a fly tipping specialist.
- Successfully advocated for legislation to tackle agriculture machinery theft by making immobilisers and forensic marking a legal requirement.
- Organised the first ever National Rural Crime Network Conference bringing together key players for the world of politics, policing, private technology companies and countryside campaigners. Established a reach into the national media to promote key rural crime issues including ITV, BBC, The Daily Telegraph, and The Sun newspapers.




